**Fall Patient Profile**

Barbara, at 70 years old, is an example of how the new art form of Aesthetic Surgery emphasizing minimally invasive procedures can produce and prolong a natural, yet youthful look for decades.



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Barbara was originally seen as a patient 13 years ago at 57 years old. She also underwent Co2 Laser resurfacing treatments at that time to the upper lip and lower eyelids. Barbara enjoyed her results for 12 ½ years.
